


WHAT IS AVAILABLE WHEN?

There may be some variability in gestational age requirements for testing. Please consult your lab of choice for specific information.

While some screening and diagnostic tests are available throughout pregnancy, they should be ordered as early as possible to facilitate timely prenatal care.







Description

Timeline indicating when prenatal tests are available over the course of a pregnancy.

Non-Invasive Prenatal Testing (NIPT) is available after 9 or 10 weeks gestation.

Multiple Marker Screening consists of enhanced First Trimester Screening (eFTS) and Second Trimester Screening (STS). eFTS is available from 11 weeks 2 days to 13 weeks 3 days gestation. STS is available from 14 weeks to 20 weeks 6 days gestation.

Ultrasound imaging includes a nuchal translucency ultrasound and a detailed anatomy ultrasound. The nuchal translucency ultrasound is available from 11 weeks 2 days to 13 weeks 3 days gestation. The detailed anatomy ultrasound is available generally from 18 weeks to 22 weeks gestation.

Diagnostic procedures include chorionic villus sampling (CVS) and amniocentesis. CVS is available from approximately 12 to 14 weeks gestation. Amniocentesis is available after approximately 15 weeks gestation.

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
